An Alternative Electric Supplier (AES), Supplier XYZ, has notified Detroit Edison that you have authorized them to be your new energy supplier at 123 Any Street, for meter number 1234567. Detroit Edison will continue to deliver that energy and bill you a distribution charge.

If you already have an interval meter, a new one may not be required. If a new meter is required, Detroit Edison will need to install it before you go to service with your new AES. 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(Paragraph based on the billing option selected by the Alternate Energy Supplier (AES)):

<b>Complete Billing</b>	Your AES has requested that Detroit Edison bill you on their behalf. Therefore, your Detroit Edison bill will provide itemized detail for both your distribution charges and your energy charges. You will pay the total amount of the bill to Detroit Edison, who will then forward the portion of the payment due to Supplier XYZ.
<b>Separate Billing</b>	Your AES has chosen to bill you directly for your energy usage. Detroit Edison will bill you separately for the distribution charges.

Please refer to the attached "What You Should Know" to learn about special meter and meter reading requirements as well as your responsibility to provide a phone line. You must notify Detroit Edison at 888.235.3535 when it is properly installed and working.

You will be notified of your scheduled "switch" date after Detroit Edison has visited your location to perform required meter work and verified successful communication from the meter to Detroit Edison's data collection systems.
